Biodegradable waste

it is composed of green waste and kitchen waste. *What you can put in:*

kitchen residues, meat, fish, fruit and vegetables, peel and cores, Dried fruits shells, egg shells, fish bones, cut flowers and the pot plants (small quantities), pasta, rice, farinaceous products, cheese, bread, coffee grounds, tea filters, chamomile, spoiled and expired food, used paper napkins, used absorbent paper, corks, toothpicks, wooden ice cream sticks, biodegradable bags, ash and sawdust (small quantities), shells (crustaceans and molluscs), bones, used paper napkins, wet or greasy kitchen paper (only really dirty, otherwise they must be thrown away in the paper and cardboard waste).

ORGANIC WASTE MAY BE THROWN AWAY IN ANY BIODEGRADABLE OR COMPOSTABLE BAG (E.G. WELL-CLOSED BIODEGRADABLE SHOPPING BAG) THAT MUST BE PUT IN THE BROWN CONTAINER.



Paper and cardboard

What you can put in:

milk, juice and food tetrapak cartons, pizza boxes without food waste or grease, newspapers, books, notebooks, paper sheets, paper bags, cardboard boxes, tissue paper, personal organizers, calendars, **paper tissues, paper.**

PAPER AND CARDBOARD MUST BE FOLDED WELL AND PUT IN THE WHITE CONTAINER, SO IT OCCUPIES THE LEAST SPACE POSSIBLE.



Mixed glass bottles and cans

What you can put in:

drinking glasses, pitchers, glass bottles, jars, tin cans and trays, aluminium foil yoghurt closure (if clean).

Dry undifferentiated waste

Dry undifferentiated waste is the part of the waste that remains after sorting and cannot be recycled.

What you can put in:

pens, felt tip pens, highlighters, erasers, pencils, tapes, rulers, pencil cases, elastic bands, blotting paper dirtied with chemical products, rubber, paper, carbon paper, plasticised, waxed, glazed, thermal, oiled objects, cosmetics, plasters, cotton wool, toothpaste tubes and toothbrushes, sanitary towels, balls,

soft toys, games, glasses and lenses, greaseproof paper, paper for food, plastic folders, costume jewellery, lighters, stubbed out cigarette

butts, candles, video/audio cassettes, floppy discs, films and negatives, cds and dvds and holders, cotton buds, combs, disposable razors, vacuum cleaner bags, umbrellas, dirty rags, labels and adhesive tape, paper and cardboard, dirty or greasy with oil or detergents, sponges, soap, makeup, dog or cat litter, yoghurt closed in tin foil, foam, fake flowers, disposable plastic cutlery, polylaminate materials (no tetrapak), dog or cat litter, yoghurt wrapped in tinfoil, stockings, chewing gum, shells (crustaceans or molluscs), buttons, photographs and x-rays.





Green

What you can put in:

brushwood, tree prunings (small quantities), leaves, bush and grass, plant residues from vegetables garden.

To subscribe the pickup service for the green waste collection fill in the form. You must book the pickup service by calling the toll free number (max 2 sacks for each service). The service is available weekly during summer from June to September and monthly during the rest of the year.

Bulky waste

For large-dimension bulky waste you can ask for collection in your municipality.

Every FRIDAY withdrawal door to door

Place your bin outside for collection from **21:00** to **24:00** the evening before collection day, near your house, by the public street.

Plastic packaging

Plastic packaging is plastic or polystyrene packaging (foam) that is wrapped around the products we buy. Plastic packaging must be placed without leftovers and volumetrically reduced.

What you can put in:

Empty plastic bottles, plastic caps, flacons (shampoo, detergents, plastic household and toiletry bottles), disposable plates and cups, plastic film or wrappers for food (pasta, rice, chips, candies, snacks, frozen foods, coffee), egg carriers, food pots and trays (for sauces, creams, yogurt, cold cuts, cheese, fruit, vegetables, ice creams, dessert), blisters, carrier bags, secondary wrap for bottles, plastic crates for fruits and vegetables, small pots, jerry cans which did not contain hazardous liquids, soil sacks, pet food bottles, foam chips, cellophane, clothes hangers.

What you cannot throw away:

plastic cutlery, toys, plastic chairs, tubes and all plastic objects that are not packaging, all waste having organic material residue (e.g.: food) or hazardous substances (paint, glue, etc.), rubber, etc.

FILL THE GRAY BAG AND CLOSE IT



WITH THE CARD CONFER THE BAG

IN THE "BANCOMAT AMICO" BIN



BAGS OUTSIDE THE BIN

WILL NOT BE COLLECTED AND WILL BE CHECKED



HOW THE BANCOMAT AMICO WORKS





PLACE THE CARD CLOSE

TO THE WRITING «CARD»



turning the handle clockwise.



DEPOSIT THE WASTE IN A BAG

that is well-closed, without it protruding from the lid. Maximum capacity 15 lt.





turning the handle anticlockwise. If the bag obstructs closing, repeat from point 2.

IN HAMLETS THE BIN IS SMALLER

CLOSE THE INDIFFERENTIATED WASTE IN THE GREY BAG

WE WILL CHECK IT WITH A BAR CODE



HOW THE ID-LOCK WORKS



PRESS THE GREY BUTTON and check the green light comes on.



insert the well-closed bag of waste.



PLACE THE CARD CLOSE and wait for the lock to unlock.
